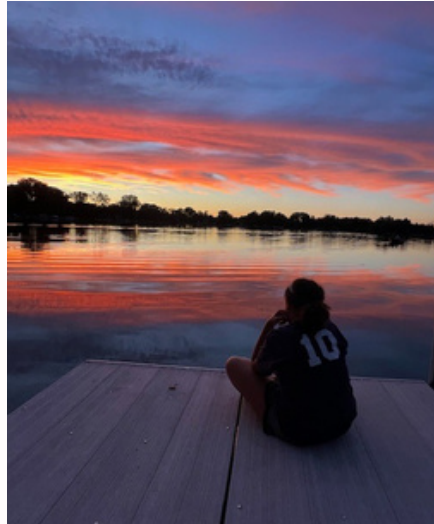

Boating Rules and Lake Safety Reminders

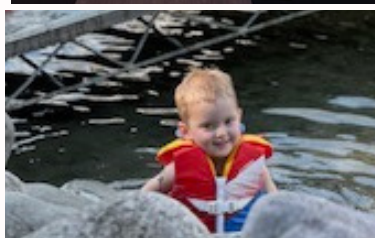
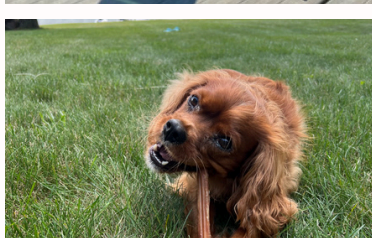
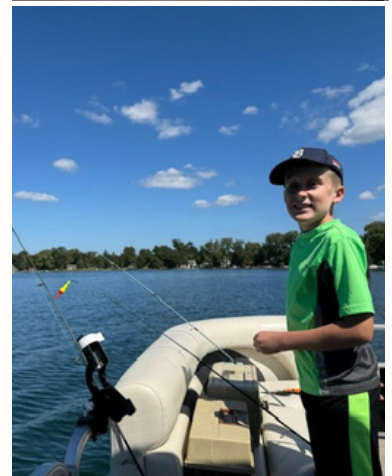
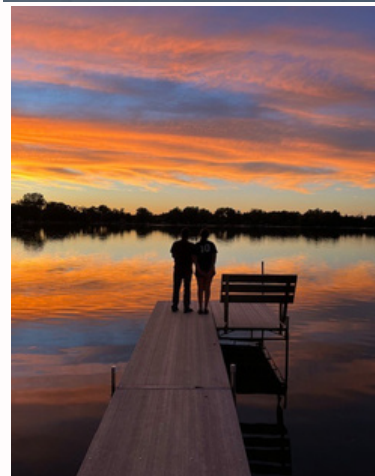
Boating Rules

- No-Wake Hours: No wake before 11:00 AM or after 6:00 PM.
- Traffic Flow: All boat traffic must follow a counter-clockwise pattern.
- Safety Gear: There must be enough life jackets for every person on your boat.
- Guest Policy: Please inform your guests of these rules.
- Environment: Be mindful of wildlife!

Traffic Safety- Please keep speeds down around the lake. Watch for walkers, children, and pets at play!

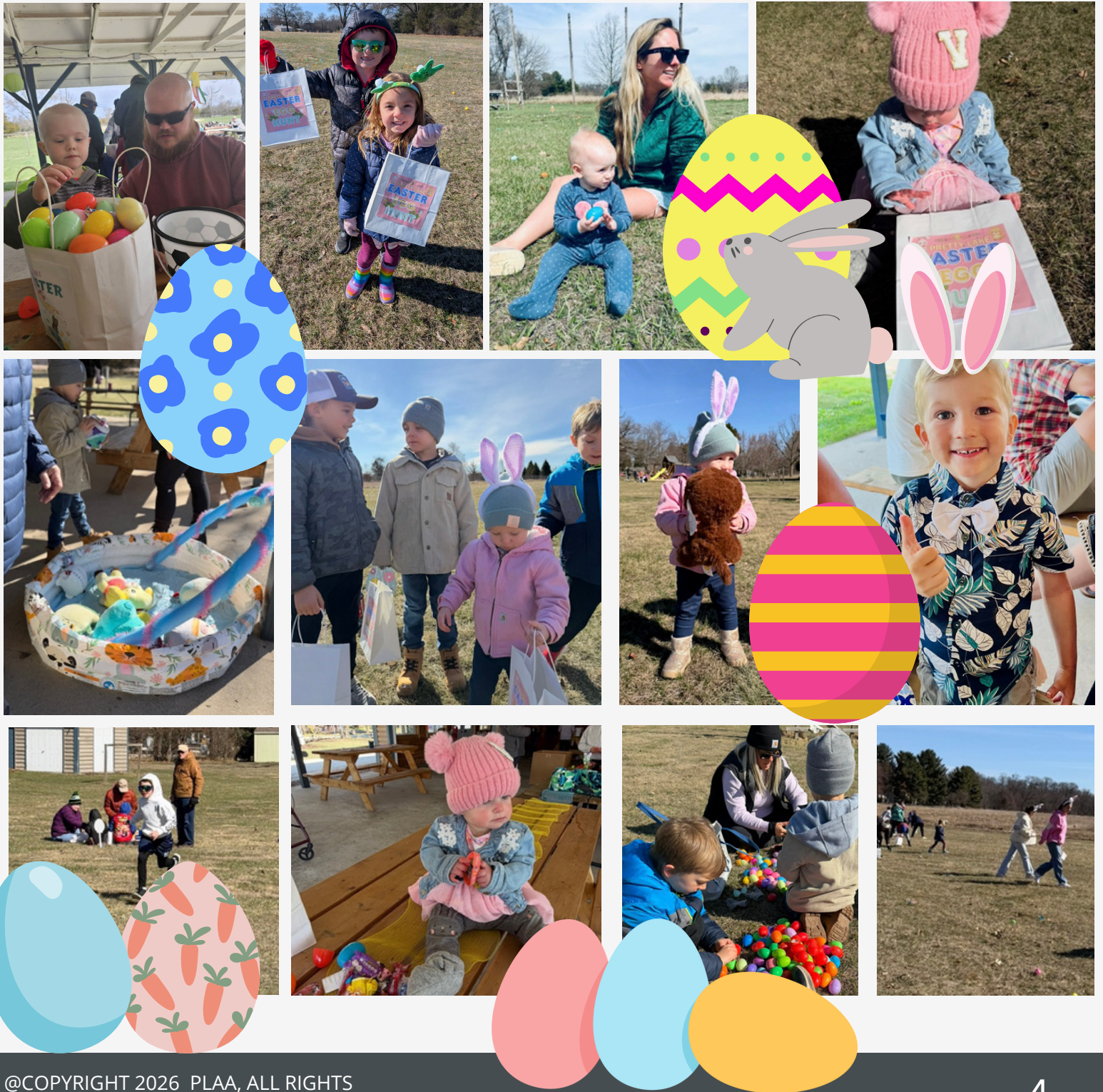

MENS NIGHT



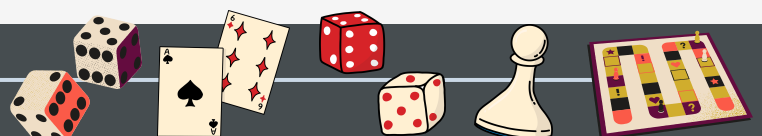

A special thank you to Brandi Binder for organizing a "Fun Run" course to keep our kids active and moving!

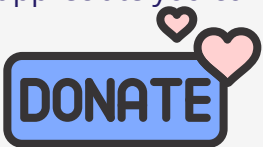

ICE FISHING JAMBOREE

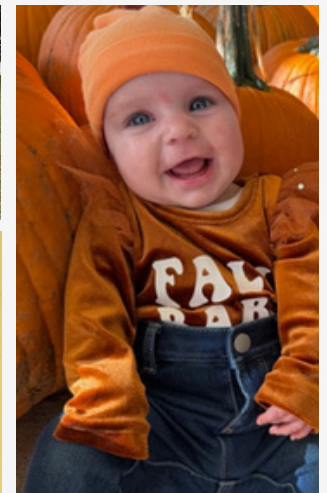

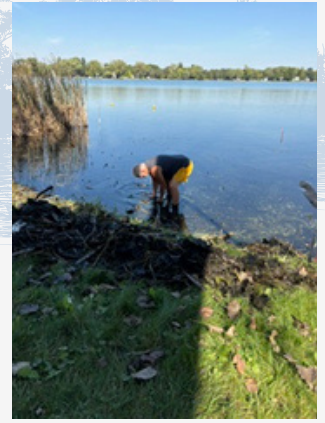
